






PUBLIC SCHOOLS

DRAFT Strategic Focus Areas

Broad directions or focus areas that impact the future by:

- Using existing strengths and opportunities within an organization
- Overcoming impeding perceptions, beliefs, assumptions and habits, as well as outmoded patterns, structures and policies
- Catalyzing movement in the direction of the organization's vision







By dismantling traditional education practices that harm students, and co-creating environments where all learners thrive, *we will*:

- Increase enrollment
- Increase academic growth
- Increase engagement, joy and a love of learning



2. Ignite innovative learning together as a community

In order to create a more relevant and engaging learning environment and to allow the community to connect with us, *we will*:

- Communicate in ways that the community needs
- Explore and expand learning options for all students
- Enhance our social-emotional curriculum and supports district-wide
- Engage all parents as partners in their child's education







3. Elevate inclusion, intersectionality and identity in all we do

FPS Timeline

Draft strategic directions shared with the community to Feb. 2023 gather feedback and identify gaps. Internal leadership team meets to refine draft plan and begin process of developing implementation plans. Core planning team and district leadership yeam revises draft Feb. - March 2023 strategic focus areas based on community feedback. Administration develops comprehensive strategic plan. Draft strategic plan (roadmap) presented to school board for March 21, 2023 review. April 2023 School board approves strategic plan. April-June 2023 Administration and core leaders finalize annual action plans. Fall 2023 New strategic plan launched.
