Health Screening Checklist for Families

Review this checklist on a daily basis before your child comes to school.

Has your child had any **one** of the **more common** following symptoms that you cannot attribute to another health condition?

- Fever 100.4 or higher
- New onset and/or worsening of cough
- Difficulty breathing
- New loss of smell or taste

OR at least **two** of the **less common** symptoms:

- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Excessive Fatigue
- New onset of severe headache
- New onset of nasal congestion or runny nose
- New loss of smell or taste

If the answer is **YES** to any of these questions, **DO NOT** send your child to school. Instead, begin isolation of your child and contact your health care provider.

OR

Has your child been in close contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 min) with anyone who has tested positive with COVID-19 within the last two weeks. If **YES, DO NOT** send your child to school. Begin quarantine for 14 days and contact your health care provider if your child develops symptoms.
