

FRIDLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT 14 REQUEST TO ADMINISTER MEDICINE AT SCHOOL

Medication Administration Policy:

Long term prescriptions (2 weeks or more) - requires a written order from a licensed prescriber, written permission from a parent/guardian and the original pharmacy labeled container.

Short term prescriptions (less than 2 weeks) - requires written permission from a parent/guardian and the original pharmacy labeled container.

Non-prescription, long and short term – requires written permission from a parent/guardian and the medication provided in the original labeled container. Administration of non-prescription medication must not exceed labeled directions. Medications must be age-appropriate (i.e., Junior Strength or Children’s if under age 12). Due to space constraints, it is helpful if you can send a smaller sized bottle with your student.
