6.	Collaborate with the middle school advisor and meet several times to ensure congruence in the program		
7.	Create and maintain an atmosphere of inclusion, not only within the council, but between other clubs and activities		
8.	Maintain membership in MASC and participate in related activities		
9.	Serve as a liaison during important climate issues between students and administration		
10.	Work collaboratively with school administration to ensure a positive atmosphere within the student council and the school in general		
11.	Seek improvement through local and state workshops as well as using NSC Student Council Advisor relationships		

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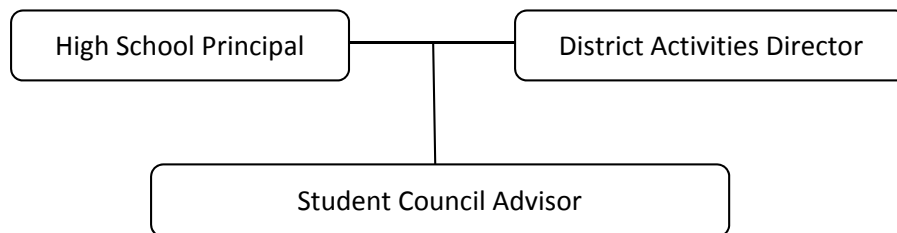
